

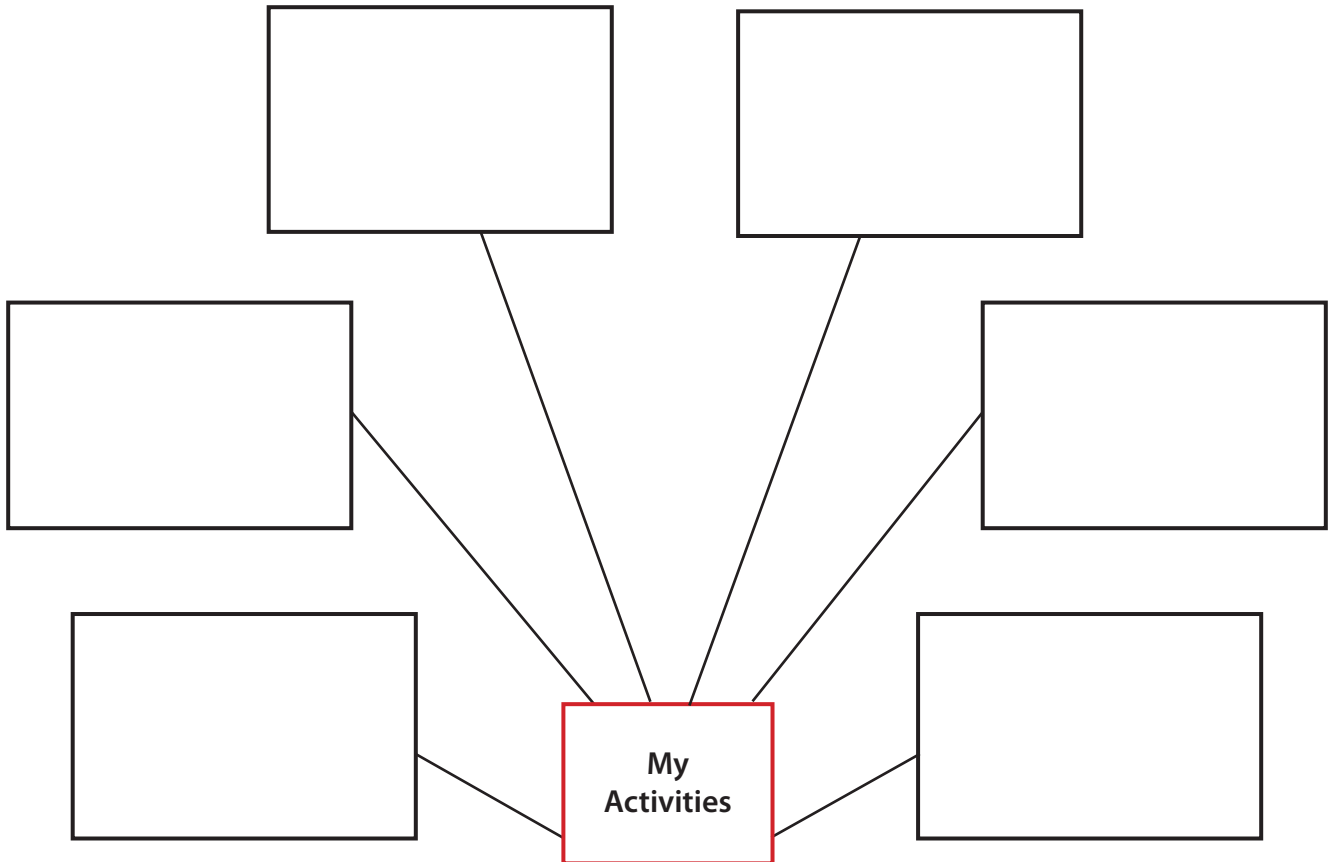
ARE YOUR FAVORITE ACTIVITIES A CLUE TO A GOOD OCCUPATIONAL MATCH?
