



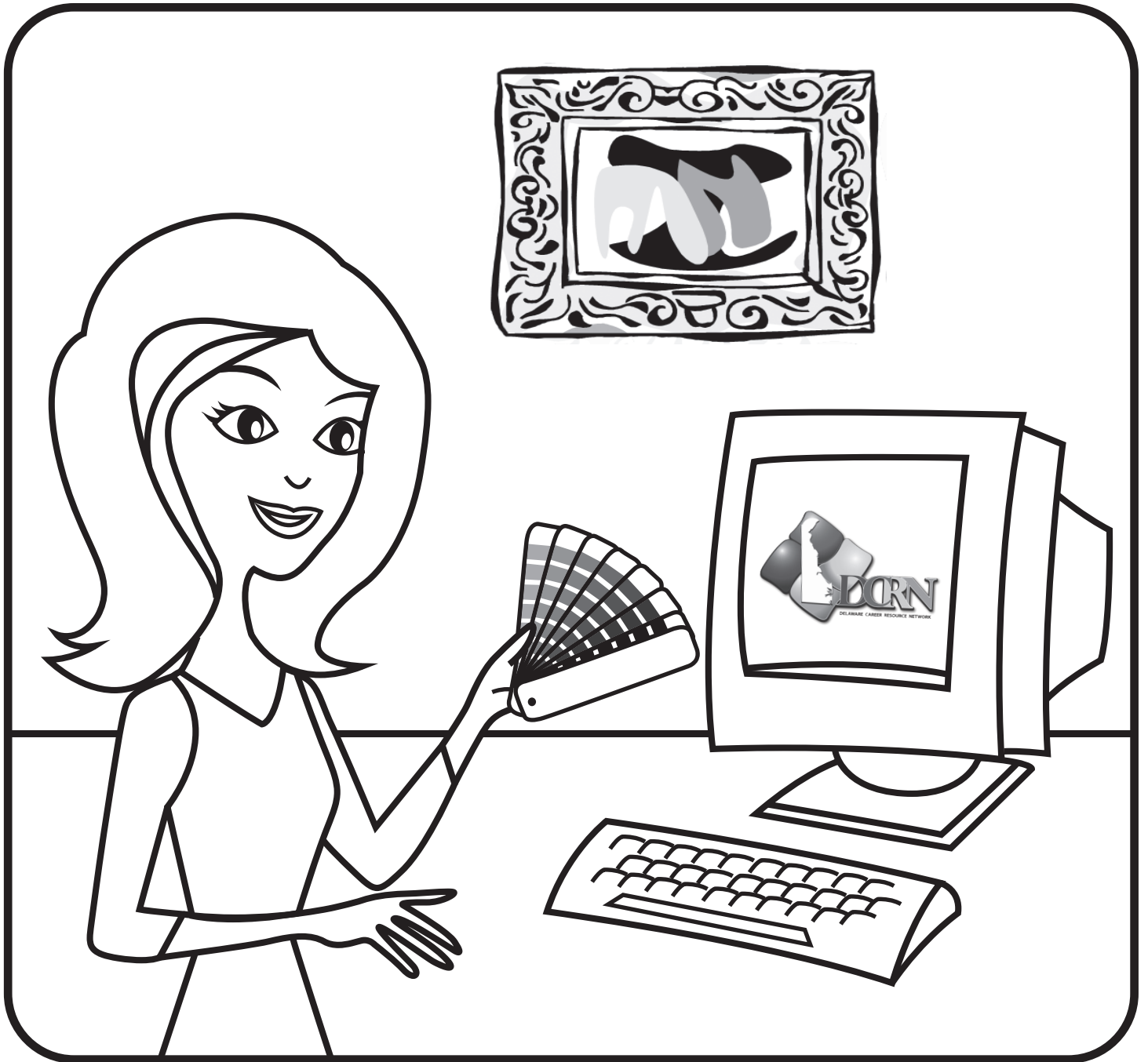

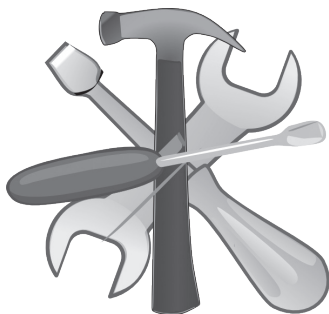

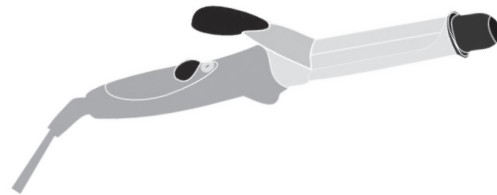
# HAIR STYLIST

Bank tellers cash checks, deposit money, and collect loan payments. They work on computers and use machines that count money.

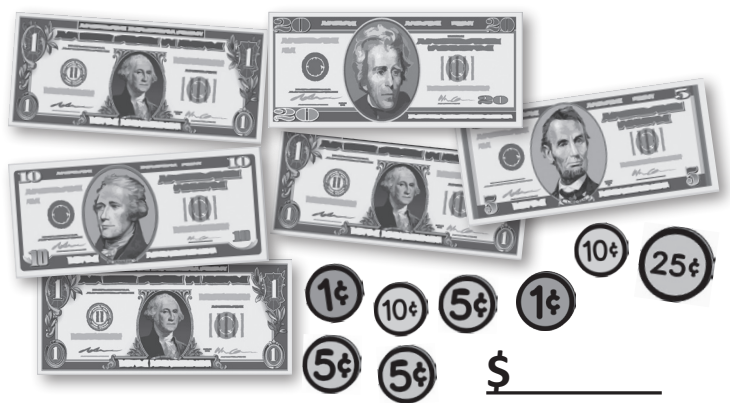
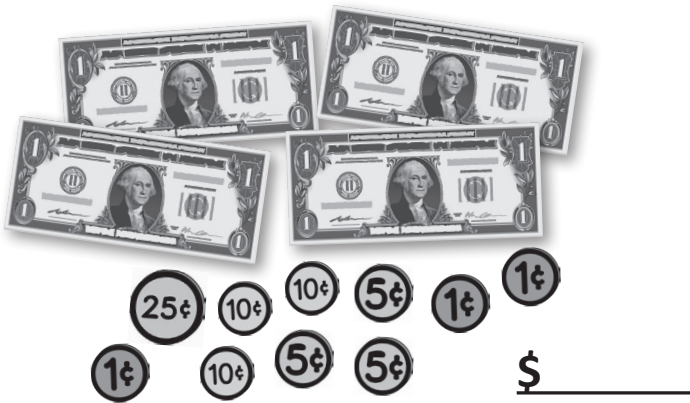
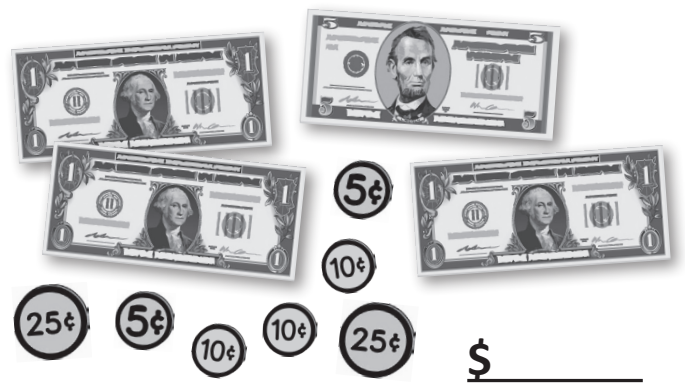

# PAINTER

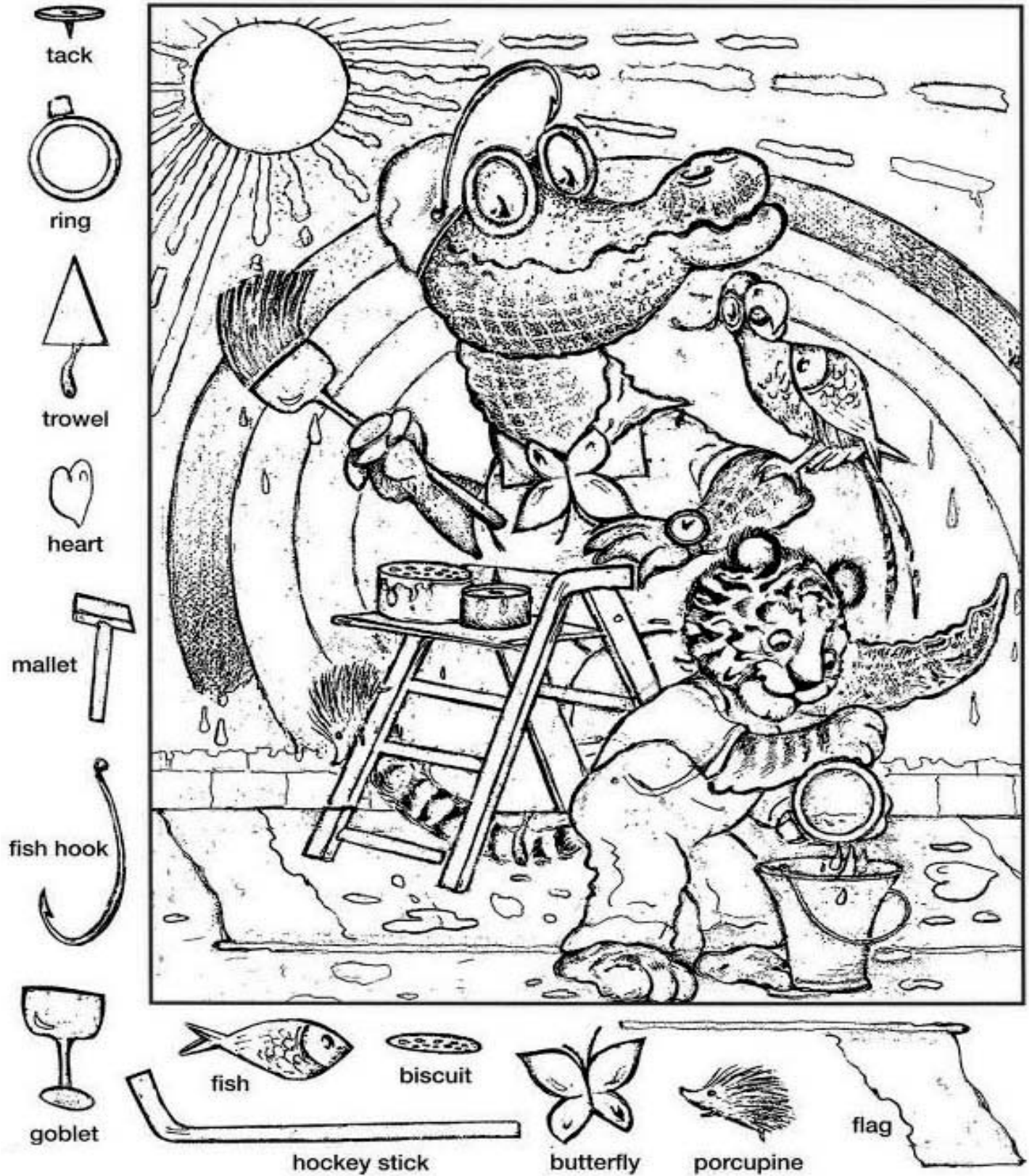


Painters choose colors and apply paint or other finishes to make surfaces look new. They do this using paint brushes, rollers, or sprayers.

# ACCOUNTANT

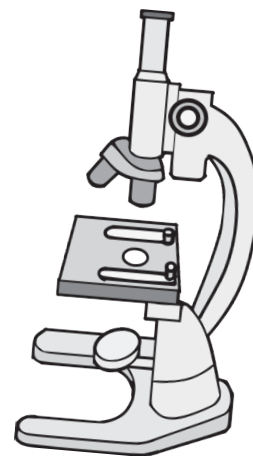


Accountants make sure financial records and statements are correct. They also make sure that taxes are paid on time.

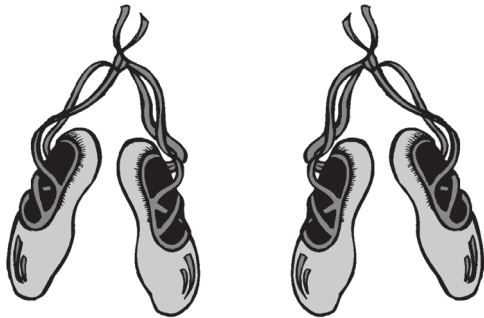


Dancers express ideas and stories using dance.

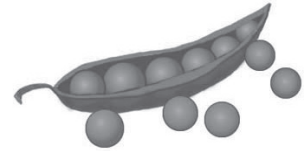
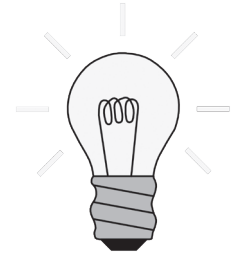
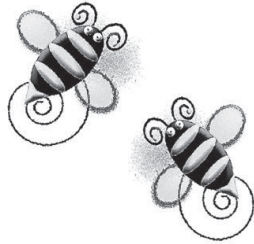
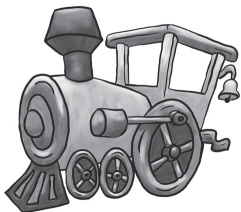
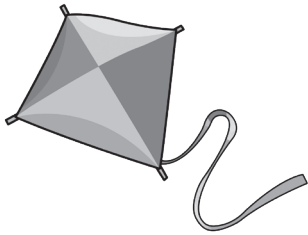
# CHILDCARE WORKER



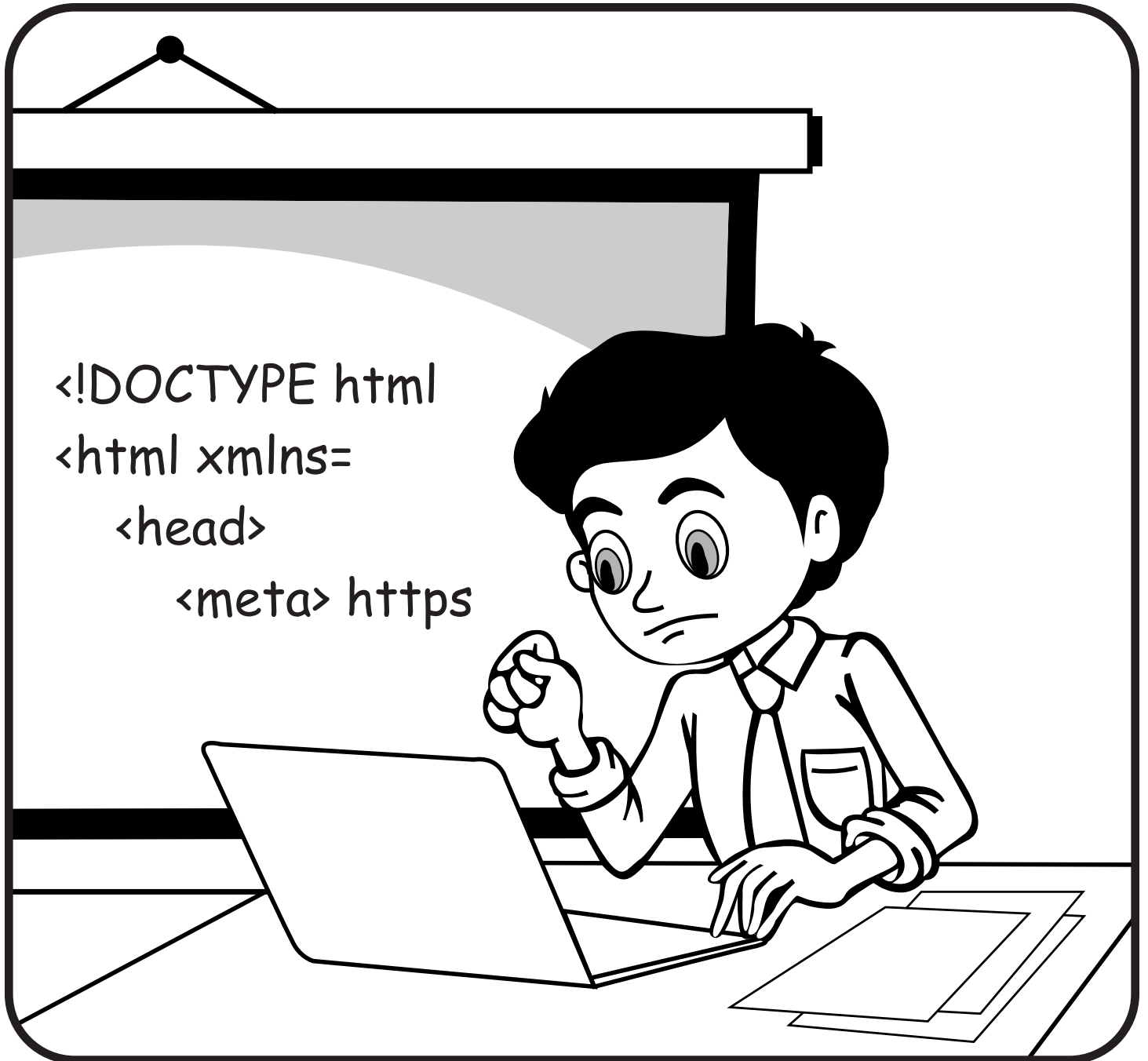
Childcare workers help children with basic needs such as dressing, feeding, and overseeing play.

Computer programmers design computer software programs. They tell computers what to do in a language called code.

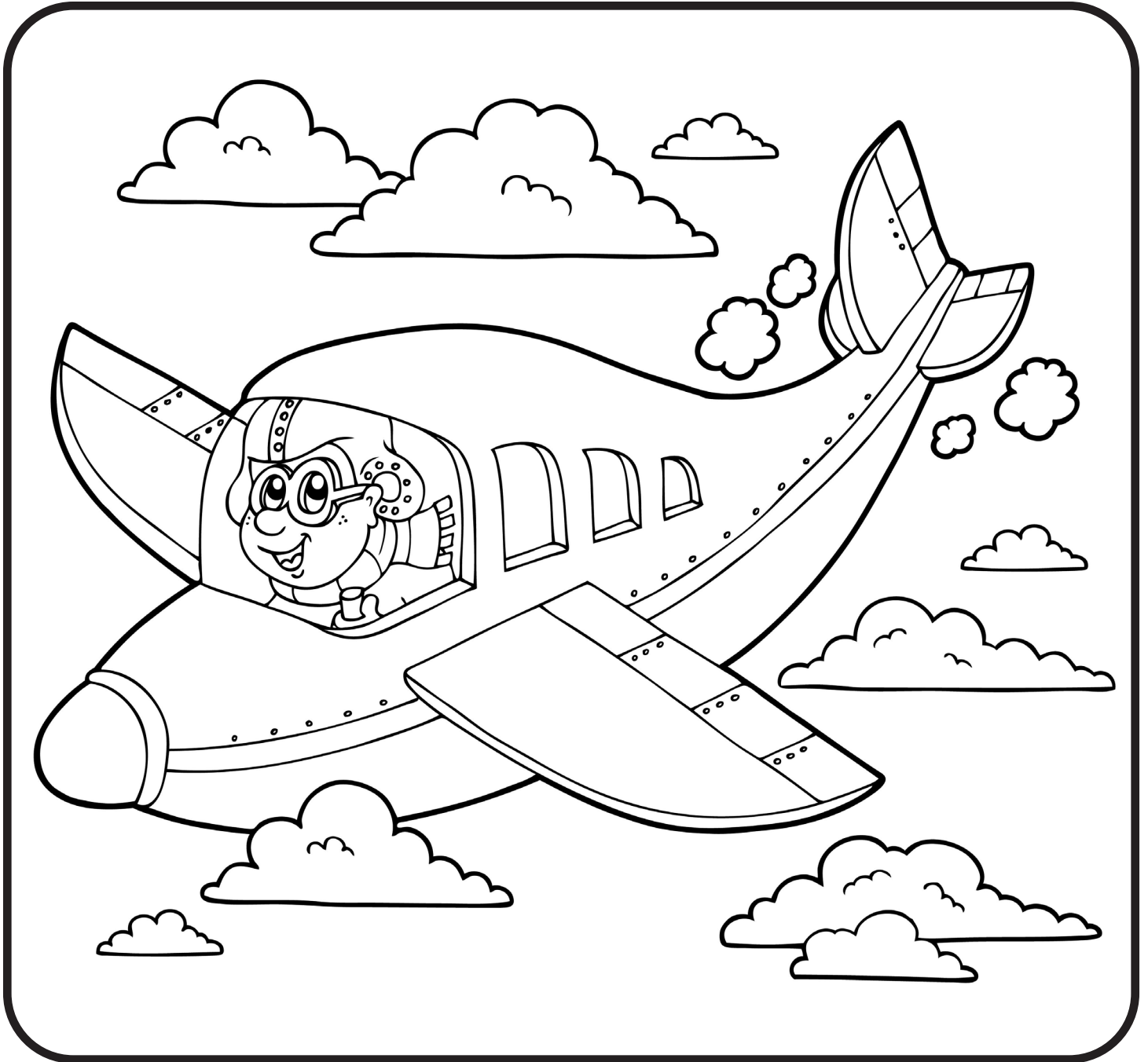

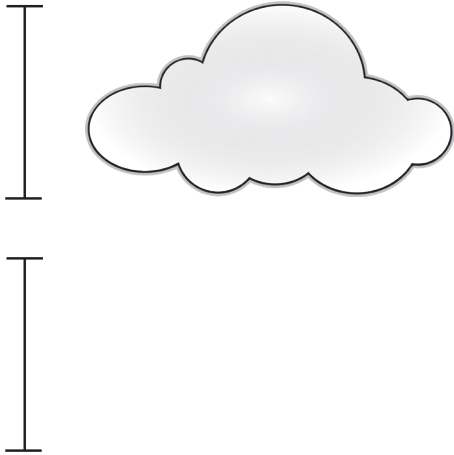

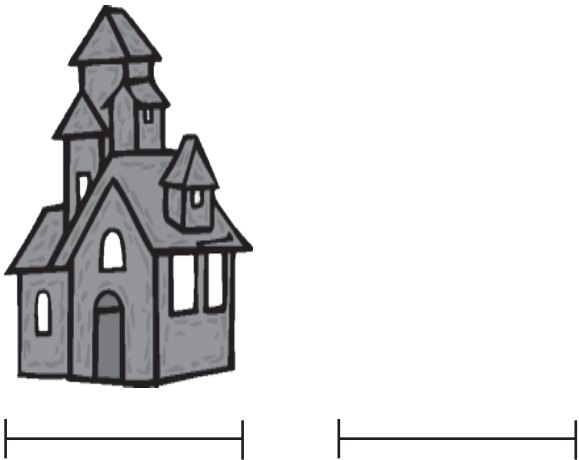
