FIDELITY BONDING PROGRAM

Gives employers the peace of mind to provide job opportunities to individuals considered at risk to hire including those who may face significant barriers.



Who is Eligibile?

- Justice involved men, women and youth
- Individuals in recovery from substance abuse
- TANF recipients
- Individuals with poor credit scores
- Economically disadvantaged youth and adults with little or no work histories
- Individuals dishonorably discharged from the military

The Process for Employers:

- The bond can be issued once the applicant has a job offer with a confirmed start date.
- The employer notifies the Delaware
 Department of Labor Bonding Program of the new hire and their eligibility.
- The Department of Labor collects the necessary information and issues the bond.

The Process for Job Seekers:

 Eligible job seekers can request a bonding letter from the Delaware Department of Labor to share with potential employers during the hiring process.

Program Benefits

- The Federal Bonding Program provides free \$5,000 fidelity bonds to protect employers against employee fraud or dishonesty.
- With no deductible, these bonds serve as an incentive to hire job seekers with barriers to employment.
- Coverage lasts for the first six months of employment and may be renewed for an additional six months.
