PURCHASE OF CARE CHILD CARE SUBSIDY PROGRAM



The Purchase of Care program provides support to eligible families seeking child care assistance.

By removing child care as a barrier to employment and health, we hope to promote independence and to help Delaware citizens to overcome poverty and prosper.

You can apply for Child Care benefits at your local Division of Social Services (DSS) office or apply online at: <u>https://assist.dhss.delaware.gov</u> The purpose of Delaware's Purchase of Care program is to provide financial support to Delaware families who need assistance paying for child care.



Child Care Eligibility

DSS determines eligibility for the Purchase of Care program based on a family's income and need for service. DSS will pay all or part of the child care expense for eligible families.

Your monthly gross income determines your eligibility and if you must pay a portion of your child care expenses.

The Purchase of Care program is available to families who have a gross income equal to or less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level and a documented need for child care services.

- Purchase of Care (POC)
- Purchase of Care Plus (POC Plus)
- Self-Arranged Care
- Relative Care

How to Apply:

You may apply at a local DSS office, online through *ASSIST*, through the mail, or by fax.

You must be interviewed by a DSS Case Worker before you can qualify for Purchase of Care.

You may need to provide one or more of the following documents:

- Proof of earned and unearned income for the past 30 days (4 pay stubs if paid weekly / 2 pay stubs if paid biweekly)
- ✓ Proof of employment
- \checkmark Proof that you are in school or training
- ✓ Proof of work/school/training schedule
- ✓ Proof of medical necessity
