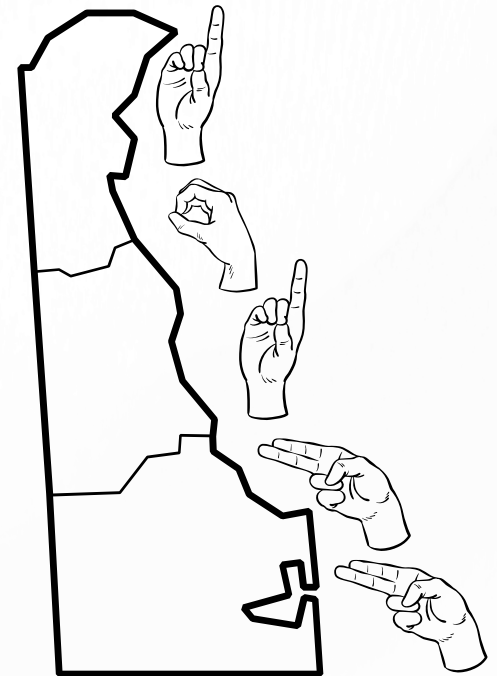

Only available through our office, a Visor Card is an official document approved through the Delaware Police Chief’s Council. Used for emergencies, the card indicates to police and other emergency personnel that the driver is Deaf or Hard of Hearing.
