OTJ at a Glance

- Q. As an employer, how do I access
 OJT training dollars?
- A. There are forms that you will have to submit to get started along with monthly progress. A DVR Counselor or Business Relations Specialist will meet with you at your place of business to discuss your needs in addition to the position for which you are seeking OJT training funds and walk you through the process.
- Q. Who can be an OJT Employer?
- A. Any company or business that has an opening for a skilled worker.
- Q. How do I benefit by participating in the OJT Program?
- A. DVR 's OJT program allows employers to be reimbursed for up to 50% of the new employee 's wages while they are in training.
- Q. What kind of positions are eligible for consideration for the OJT program?
- A. Occupations with growth potential that suit both the employer and trainee and result in permanent employment for the trainee.
