AM I ELIGIBLE?

An Individualized Education Program (IEP), 504 plan, or other documented disability are some of the sources used to determine eligibility for high school students.

Eligibility provides you with access to **job shadowing, internships, and self-advocacy.** DVR may also provide students with opportunities to explore **post-secondary education and career training programs.**
