Monthly Commentary

Delaware's May unemployment rate of 4.2 percent is the lowest rate since just prior to the COVID-19 pandemic in February 2020 when the unemployment rate was 3.7 percent. The number of employed workers increased by 2,300 or 0.5%, continuing the over-the-month upward trend in employment that began in December 2022. May's Labor Force Participation (LFP) rate also grew from 59.8 to 59.9 over the month as 2,000 workers were added to Delaware's labor force, the largest monthly gain since December 2020. Total non-farm jobs reached 485,700, their highest level since record-keeping began in 1990.

Delaware Labor Force Trends

Delaware's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in May 2023 was 4.2%, down from 4.3% in April 2023. There were 21,200 unemployed Delawareans in May 2023 compared to 21,500 in May 2022. The US unemployment rate was 3.7% in May 2023, up from 3.4% in April 2023. In May 2022, the US unemployment rate was 3.6%, while Delaware's rate was 4.3%.

In May 2023, seasonally adjusted nonfarm employment was 485,700, up from 483,700 in April 2023. Since May 2022, Delaware's total nonfarm jobs have increased by a net gain of 14,700, a rise of 3.1 %. Nationally, jobs during that period increased 2.6%.


